SPECIAL NOTE - This site will be cordoned off from the public, with **STRICTLY** no entry to this area during the preparation, display and conclusion in the above time slot or for as long as needed by the Fireworks operator and Dublin City Council.

No bonfires must be set in Donaghmede Park as a Health & Safety precaution in view of the FIREWORKS display.
